### **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)**

#### *Minutes of the meeting held on 28 July 2012*

The meeting was held on Saturday, 28 July 2012 and it was presided over by the Principal and Chairperson of IQAC Dr. K. R. Aher.

The meeting deliberated on the agenda items and decided the following:

- Faculty should explore the funding agencies for hosting academic events like conferences, seminar and workshops.
- Faculty namely, K. K. Dixit, Prof. A. N. Khobragade (both Dept of English) and Prof. R. D. Mundhe (Dept of Marathi), whose Minor Research Project proposals were approved by the UGC (in March 2011), should provide the updates of their respective studies
- As the results of students are not encouraging the faculty should strive to improve students' results by taking appropriate measures
- College should initiate social awareness raising activities through NSS and Extension Activities Cell such as gender sensitization and drug addiction

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### Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC meeting was held on Tuesday, 30 April 2013 to discuss the progress on action plan for the session 2012-13.

The Action Taken Report was presented by the Coordinator Prof. S. O. Raghuvanshi and was approved.

#### Action Taken Report (ATR)

1. Proposal for the organization of National Level Conferences were prepared and submitted to the UGC. The details are as follows:
  - Dept. of Sociology: Farmer Suicides and Agriculture in the Vidarbha Region
  - Dept. of Economics: FDI Flows and the Indian Economy
  - Dept. of Physical Education: Stress Management and Sport Psychology
  - Dept. of English: Teaching of English in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century
  - Dept. of History: Raja Shivaji and Maharashtra
2. The progress of Minor Research Projects namely, “A Study of Motivation of Teachers of English in Rural Area” (K. K. Dixit), “A Study of English Reading Habits of Rural Students Studying for UG Degree Courses” (Prof. A. N. Khobragade), and “A Critical Study of Complete Poetry by Namdev Dhasal” (Prof. R. D. Mundhe) is satisfactory. The studies are in data collection phase.
3. Hemoglobin Checking Camp was organised by the Home Economics department in which 80 students participated. NSS unit organised “Anti-Tobacco campaign and AIDS awareness rally. Extension Unit organised a one day workshop on gender sensitization “*Kali Umaltana*” in collaboration with Indian Women Organisation (*Bhartiya Stree Sanghtana*)
4. The cell informed the departments and the academic committee to give more emphasis on the academics of the weak students and not to restrict the number of internal examinations to the minimum as suggested by the University. The departments are urged to effectively run remedial mechanisms.
