Minutes of the meeting held on 27 July 2013

The meeting was held on Saturday, 27 July 2013 and it was presided over by the Principal and Chairperson of IQAC Dr. K. R. Aher.

The meeting deliberated on the agenda items and decided the following:

- The IQAC should follow-up with the UGC about the National Level Conference proposals submitted by the Dept. of Sociology, Dept. of Economics, Dept. of Physical Education, Dept. of English and Dept. of History.
- Faculty namely, K. K. Dixit, Prof. A. N. Khobragade (both Dept of English) and Prof. R. D. Mundhe (Dept of Marathi), whose Minor Research Project proposals are approved by the UGC (in March 2011), should present the findings of their studies or provide updates about the progress, as the case may be.
- As the results of students are not encouraging the faculty should strive to improve students' results by taking appropriate measures.
- College should initiate social awareness raising activities through NSS and Extension Activities Cell
- Complete the recruitment process of the faculty in Political Science

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The IQAC meeting was held on Wednesday, 30 April 2014 to discuss the progress on action plan for the session 2013-14.

The Action Taken Report was presented by the Coordinator Prof. S. O. Raghuvanshi and was approved.

Action Taken Report (ATR)

1. The college is following-up with the UGC regarding the approval of submitted conference proposals by Dept. of Sociology, Dept. of Economics, Dept. of Physical Education, Dept. of History, and Dept. of English.
2. The progress of Minor Research Projects namely, “A Study of Motivation of Teachers of English in Rural Area” (K. K. Dixit), “A Study of English Reading Habits of Rural Students Studying for UG Degree Courses” (Prof. A. N. Khobragade), and “A Critical Study of Complete Poetry by Namdev Dhasal” (Prof. R. D. Mundhe) presented the preliminary findings of their respective studies.
3. Two faculty members namely, Dr. A. S. Dahane (Dept. of Physical Education) and Dr. S. B. Kale (Dept. of Political Science) have submitted Minor Research Project proposals to the UGC.
4. Social awareness activities such as “Road Safety Campaign” and “National Voters’ Day” were organized by the NSS wing of the college.
5. Co-curricular activities such as “Mock Parliament” (organized by Dept of Political Science) and a guest lecture on “Competitive Examinations) were successfully organized.
