Academic Year: 2023-24

1. Academic Performance

Feedback Summary:

- Students, Alumni, and Parents provided overall positive ratings for teaching quality, course materials, curriculum alignment, and assessment methods.
- Despite the positive feedback, several respondents highlighted the need for introducing additional certificate courses to enhance skill development. Specifically:
- Spoken English Certificate Course: To improve communication skills and fluency.
- Computer-related Courses: To provide essential digital literacy and technological skills relevant to current job markets and higher studies.

Actions Taken:

Introduction of a Spoken English Certificate Course:

- A comprehensive Spoken English certificate course has been developed to help students improve their language proficiency, public speaking, and overall communication skills.
 - Course Details:
 - Duration: 3 months.
 - Content: Basics of grammar, vocabulary building, pronunciation, conversation practice, and interview skills.
 - Faculty: Experienced language instructors and guest lecturers from reputed institutes.
 - The course will be offered starting from the upcoming semester, and registration details will be communicated to students well in advance.

Introduction of Computer-related Certificate Courses:

- Recognizing the importance of digital skills, a set of computer-related courses will be introduced, focusing on:
- Basic Computer Literacy (MS Office, Internet Usage, Email).
- Advanced Skills (Data Analysis, Digital Marketing, Programming Fundamentals).
- Course Structure:

- Duration: 3-6 months, depending on the module.
- Practical Training: Hands-on workshops in the computer lab.
- Outcomes: Equip students with skills essential for employment and further education.

Ongoing Curriculum Review:

The institution will continue to review and align course materials with program objectives to ensure they meet evolving academic and industry standards.

2. Infrastructure and Facilities
